## Major reshuffle at Zurich law firm

There is a change in the top management position at the Lalive law firm, which specializes in arbitration and litigation. Other personnel changes will also take place at the turn of the year.

**Tom Brown** takes over the position of Managing Partner at Lalive from **Domitille Baizeau**, who has held the position of CEO since 2020.
